



FIA SAFETY HOMOLOGATION ASN REWARD PROGRAMME APPLICATION FOR REWARD

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THIS FORM

INTRODUCTION

The FIA Safety Department launched the FIA Safety Homologation ASN Reward Programme (hereinafter the "Programme") in 2017.

Within this Programme, the FIA will reward ASNs that comply with the FIA safety equipment regulations in 13 specific categories as listed in Section 2. Subject to the prior approval of the FIA, each ASN applying to this Programme will be entitled to receive a reward amount which will take into consideration the number of categories the ASN mandates listed in Section 2 and the number of drivers and co-drivers licence holders (hereinafter the "Reward"), detailed in this application form. ASNs that are eligible for a reward less than €3,000 will be automatically granted €3,000.

Please note that any ASN that submits an application for Reward funding under the FIA Safety Homologation ASN Reward Programme is also required to submit:

- i) the total number of drivers and co-drivers licence holders with national or international licence issued by the ASN.
- ii) a statement to the FIA to confirm that they will provide information to the World Accident Database (WADB) for any accident that falls into any of the WADB categories (Fatal Accident, Serious Accident and Significant Incident).

The objectives of this Programme are to:

1. Increase safety of drivers worldwide through the deployment of state-of-the-art motor sport safety protection, including at the national level.
2. Improve safety at the grassroots level, which has historically been the most difficult market. This will have the biggest impact on global motor sport safety.

Eligibility guidelines for each of the 13 categories covered by this Programme are described in this application form.

HOW TO APPLY

Each ASN interested in receiving a Reward must complete this application form (hereinafter the "Application").

Applications will open on 21 April 2021 and close at 18:00hrs CET on 21 May 2021 – applications received after this date cannot be accepted.

Please complete all pages of the Application form, just answer 'No' for categories of equipment that you do not intend to mandate at this time.

As part of the application, for those categories where you answer 'Yes', you will have to provide a list of Technical and/or Sporting Regulations to demonstrate compliance with the FIA regulations for each specific product. We will supply an Excel sheet for you to complete to list the relevant documents. The FIA reserves the right to ask the Applicant to provide a copy of each Technical/Sporting regulation listed in accordance with Section 2 and to highlight the sections that demonstrate the ASN regulation fully complies with the corresponding FIA Regulations.

Exceptionally in 2021 ASNs will not be requested to use the Reward solely for safety projects. Each ASN that receives a Reward will be required to report on their use of the funds. Reporting requirements will be communicated to successful ASNs when the Reward is provided. We expect to notify ASNs of funding decisions in Q3.

All the Mini-Karting competitions organised under the authority of the ASN in its country, either by itself or by its affiliate clubs, in all the motor sport events (International, National and Local regional championships, Cups, Challenges, Trophies and Series (except for one-day Club events)) mandate the use of karting high seats in accordance with the FIA Standard 8873-2018 as regulated by the CIK-FIA technical regulation.

6. We acknowledge and confirm that:

 - 6.2. in the event that our application is successful, the Reward payment may be suspended at any time if the financial situation of the ASN has a debit balance on the FIA account.

We confirm that our ASN will submit a statement to the FIA to confirm that we will provide and will continue to provide on a regular basis and until the end of the current year, any relevant data to the World Accident Database (WADB) for any accident that falls into any of the WADB categories (Fatal Accident, Serious Accident and Significant Incident).

11. Should this Application be approved, we acknowledge that the FIA shall be entitled, during the current and for the following period of two years, to conduct, either by itself or by auditors or other advisers appointed by it, a review at the ASN facilities (or other location agreed by the FIA and the ASN) of the ASN's execution of the Programme and use of the Reward.

12. Should this Application be approved, we will provide our ASN banking details to the FIA in order to receive the corresponding Reward amount allocated to our ASN and confirm how such amount will be used.
